Tank Requirements

- Size: Minimum of 15 gallons
- Water Temperature: 70-78°F (21-26°C)
- pH Level: 6.0-7.5
- Tank setup: A mix of open swimming spaces and plants or decorations for hiding

- Diet:
 - High-quality flake food or micro-pellets
 - Occasional live or frozen foods like brine shrimp or daphnia
- Social Behavior:
 - Peaceful and schooling fish, best kept in groups of 5 or more
 - Compatibility with other small, peaceful fish

 - Watch for signs of stress or disease (e.g., fading color, lethargy).
